SELECTION CRITERIA

PURPOSE OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE STRATEGIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

To provide advice and guidance on the development of strategies, and identification of challenges and opportunities, in relation to built and natural facilities and systems within the LGA, including coastal revitalisation programs, building and facility upgrades, environmental matters including coastal and floodplain management, stormwater, transport and cycleways delivery.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- i. Professional experience in one or more of the following civil engineering, infrastructure management, sports infrastructure, planning for integrated public and active transport services, environmental management or related fields.
- ii. Demonstrated interest and understanding of planning programs for improved community outcomes.
- iii. Experience in evaluating infrastructure management options to achieve triple bottom line outcomes.

Applicants must submit a statement of no more than two pages outlining how they meet the selection criteria and how this relates to the purpose of the committee.

The selection criteria should be read with the Terms of Reference for this Committee, available here.

A completed application form must accompany your statement of claims. This form can be completed online on the Advisory Committee EOI web page, or attached to email applications (available here).

Applicants should expect to be able to commit to meetings of approx. 2 hours at least four times per year on a Tuesday afternoon / evening, or as resolved by the Committee.
